## Welcome!

Happy Holidays fourth grade families and welcome to the 2021 School Year! I hope everyone enjoys their long (well deserved) winter break and finds some time to finally enjoy the snow! The fourth grade team is VERY proud of your children and all they have accomplished in **seventeen** weeks.

In January, students will being their next science unit, environment and ecology. We will learn about food chains, producers, consumers, decomposers, wetlands, and also the water cycle

In mathematics, we will begin our fractions and decimals unit. Students will learn how to decompose, add, subtract, multiply, and compare fractions. We will also learn how to make equivalent fractions!

In language arts, students will continue their study of non-fiction texts. We will learn about text structures and how they help us comprehend what we are reading. We will focus on comparing and contrasting, sequential order, cause and effect, problem and solution, and also description. We will then learn about inferences as well as how to identify main idea and details in order to compose a summary.
